### **CHILDREN'S CATEGORIES**

#### **Class A | Pre-school**

- A1. Colouring-in picture (available from Rawdon Community Library)
- A2. Finger Painting. Max size 30 x40cm

#### **Class B | Foundation / Key Stage 1 (Age 4-7)**

- B1. Vegetable creature
- B2. Miniature garden in a shoe box. Use a variety of natural and recycled materials, to create a garden scene.
- B3. Design an anti-litter poster to "Keep Rawdon Tidy" (A4 size).
- B4. Four crispy cakes, made from breakfast cereal and presented in bun cases.

#### **Class C | Key Stage 2 (Age 7-11)**

- C1. Junk model made from recycled materials. Maximum base size 40x40cm.
- C2. Poem or piece of creative writing, on the theme of 'Growing'. Present on one side only (for display purposes). Decoration optional.
- C3. . Design an anti-litter poster to "Keep Rawdon Tidy" (A4 size).
- C4. Decorated cake. To be judged on appearance.

### **OPEN TO ALL**

#### **Class D | Craft (Class D entries by children will be judged separately from adults)**

- D1. Handmade bag. Any medium
- D2. Amigurumi – small stuffed creature – any stitch craft.
- D3. Cushion Cover, any stitch craft
- D4. Handmade greeting card

## **Class E | Cooking**

E1. Victoria sponge (jam filling only)

E2. 3 pieces of Parkin to a given recipe available to download from the library website or collect from the counter.

E3. Lemon Drizzle Cake

E4. Homemade bread, loaf or free-form

E5. Jar of homemade jam

E6. Jar of homemade chutney/pickle

## **Class F | Garden Produce and Plants – must have been grown by the exhibitor**

F1 Vase of mixed garden flowers and foliage

F2. A rose stem, single or floribunda

F3. A garden flower or spray on a single stem

F4. Houseplant. Foliage or flowering (must have been owned for one year minimum).

## **Class G | Floral Art**

G1. A flower arrangement in an unusual container

G2. Miniature flower arrangement (max. size 12cm/5" tall or wide)

## **Class H | Art and Photography**

H1. A picture (any medium except photography)

H2. Photography - 'Then and Now'. Find an old picture of our local area. Photograph the view as it is now and display both together. (Maximum size each 5"x7")

H3. Photograph of an animal/pet

I1. Humorous caption competition –photo available from library
