
# Rawdon Community Library

Our <u>Community Interest Groups</u> are operating their regular Autumn/Winter schedules. <u>Crochet, Needlecrafts, Gardening, French, Spanish, Local History, Railway Group, Scrabble, Sewing B, Reading Group and our friendly <u>Coffee Morning and Afternoon each Tuesday</u>.</u>

If you know of anyone who would like a book delivery this winter, please leave a contact number with the Library Counter Staff. You might even get a biscuit with your book!


